


Rose du Sable



By Plane

The airline Royal Air Maroc (RAM) flies several times per week from Düsseldorf, Frankfurt, Geneva, Basle-Mulhouse, Munich and Zürich to Morocco. The major hub in the North African country is Casablanca. You can take connecting flights from the modern "Aéroport International de Mohammed V" airport to Agadir, Marrakesh and Ouarzazate. The low-cost airline Atlas Blue operates several return flights to Marrakech each week from Basle-Mulhouse and Geneva.

You can hire a car in Ouarzazate in order to reach us by road. Otherwise, we are also quite happy to organise a transfer to our hotel by car. The journey from the airport to Agdz takes around one hour.

By Car

Morocco can also be reached by car from Central Europe (ferry connections from southern Spain to Tangiers/Melilla or southern France to Tangiers).

It is also possible to hire a car with or without a driver in Morocco. Anyone who knows Morocco a little and has enough time can head for the Vallée du Drâa on several interesting routes. From Agadir on the Atlantic coast you can travel to Tazenakht via Taroudant and Taliouine. Four-wheel drives can take the track via Tasla to reach Agdz directly from the west. Travelling from Marrakesh you can choose between two fabulous passes over the Atlas Mountains. The quickest route is via the Tizi-n-Tichka pass (2260m) to Ouarzazate, which takes you through the fascinating village of Ait Benhaddou. The other option is to travel over the Tizi-n-Test pass (2092m), which is further south from Marrakesh. This journey takes you through the region of Jbel Toubkal near Asni. At 4167m this is the highest mountain in North Africa.

From the north you reach Ouarzazate via the Vallée du Dades and then continue via the Tizi-n-Tiniffitt pass to Agdz.

You reach the Rose du Sable by taking the main road north from the large square in the centre of Agdz. (there is a sign for the hotel on the junction) and driving through original old neighbourhoods. After around 1.5 kilometres you will reach a large square; our hotel is located on the right.

Another interesting option is to head for the large oasis of Tafilalt around the villages of Erfoud and Rissani. From there a little-used desert road leads to Tazzarine, where you will find our partner hotel the Riad du Sud. On the way you can stop off at the village of N'Kob (a secret tip!) and soon reach the Vallée du Drâa.
